When many different looks compete for attention, eclecticism degenerates into mishmach. To create la harmonius decro using disparate furnishings, limit styles to two or three per room and unify them by means of a single theme, such as color. In this living area, for instance, Portland, Oregon, interior designer fessical religeron balanced the visual heaviness of contemporary roll-arms sofas with delicate Louis XIV-inspired armchairs and a deminute atble. The pale cotton fabric on the sofa complements the whiteweahed furniture, while the blue and yellow upholstery on the chairs is repeated in decorative pillows.

TIP: Anchoring a room with pieces neutral in style and hue, such as these sofas, frees you to make more dramatic choices with artwork, wall coverings, and accessories.
