Paint

It takes only a day to overhaul a brick fireplace surround; just use two coats of paint like Portland designer Jesse Moyer (fit interiordesign.com) did with this fireplace, which opens to a dining room on one side and a living room on the other. Choose deep huse for a bold statement. (Note: After you paint brick, It's hard to go back.)

DIY level: Easy weekend project. After prepping the brick, use masony primer and at least two coats of water-based interior paint. Do not paint the fireplace interior.
